Disposal of Confiscated FM Radio Receivers

This notice serves to inform concerned retailers, distributors and dealers of NICTA's intention to dispose all FM radio receivers that were confiscated by NICTA Inspectors in Port Moresby, Lae and Kokopo/Rabaul in September 2012.

The imported FM radio receivers were manufactured with the capability to receive radio broadcast signals in the FM frequency band outside the approved range of 88.0 MHz to 108.0 MHz in PNG.

NICTA is hereby giving a one month period up to December 1, 2012 for the companies listed below to contact NICTA to express objection.

Immediately after December 1, 2012, all confiscated FM radio receivers that are now in NICTA's possession will be disposed of appropriately under police supervision. In future, all such confiscated FM radio receivers will be destroyed without notice.
