#### **Extension of Deadline for Submissions in Response to the Public Inquiry – Phase II (Draft Determination: Service-specific Pricing Principles For Mobile And Fixed Terminating Access Services )**

#### **Extension of Public Inquiry**

The National Information and Communication Technology Authority (NICTA) is currently conducting its *Phase II of Public Inquiry into Service Specific Pricing Principles (SSPP) for the Domestic Mobile and Fixed Termination Access Service*. In our initial public notice to conduct Phase II of the Public Inquiry, we advise that the Public Inquiry will end on 14<sup>th</sup> December 2025.

The deadline for Submission is extended to 30<sup>th</sup> January 2026 for stakeholders to make submission to NICTA.

The reason for extension is to give ample time to stakeholders to provide comments and responses regarding this matter. The extension is also made to give NICTA enough time to provide responses to the comments and responses provided by the stakeholders and ensure they are addressed adequately.
