Extension to notice on Call for Comments 1. Draft 60 GHz Band Plan and Background paper

In accordance with sections 219 and 229 of the National Information and Communications Technology Act, 2009 ("the Act"), NICTA has commenced public consultation on the following draft Spectrum band plan.

• Draft 60 GHz Band Plan

The Band Plans propose the use of the radiofrequency spectrum in the 60 GHz for mobile communication services in Papua New Guinea.

The public consultation was conducted over a month ago and is **EXTENDED** for another 30 days. The closing date for written comments is **Wednesday 13th September 2023.**

NICTA is extending the invitation to stakeholders and interested parties to consider and comment on the consultation documents. All written submissions should be emailed to consultation.spectrum@nicta.gov.pg or hand delivered to NICTA Head Office.
