Draft Rule on Reference Interconnection Offers

In accordance with sections 141 and 218 of the National Information & Communications Technology Act 2009 ("the Act"), NICTA intends to make rules specifying the acceptable forms for reference interconnection offers (RIOs).

Under the Act, an operator licensee that supplies a declared service may submit to NICTA for its approval a RIO setting out the terms and conditions under which the licensee will supply access seekers with the declared service to fulfil its non-discrimination obligations. NICTA has prepared the draft rule and is now engaging in public consultation as required by s.229 of the Act.
