#### PUBLIC CONSULTATION

# Proposed Variation to the Licence Conditions Rule $2011 - 2^{nd}$ Round

The National Information and Communications Technology Act 2009 (the Act) section 55 provides for NICTA to "make rules setting out the standard terms and conditions, and any special terms and conditions, for individual licences." The current rules, which appear on NICTA's website at <a href="https://www.nicta.gov.pg/licensing/terms-conditions">https://www.nicta.gov.pg/licensing/terms-conditions</a>, were developed in 2011 and have not been changed since then.

NICTA held a first round of consultations in October 2023 on proposed variations to the 2011 Rule on Standard and Special Conditions of Individual Licences. A number of submissions were received and many had very useful suggestions for change that NICTA has considered.

NICTA is now holding a second-round consultation on the amended proposed variations to the Rule, and invites all stakeholders and interested members of the public to make submissions on their views in relation to the proposed variations to the 2011 Rule.

In particular, the licenses that are directly affected by the changes are encouraged to make submissions with their comments, and may wish to offer comments on earlier submissions that have been received, all of which are posted on the NICTA website at <a href="https://www.nicta.gov.pg/cp-0-33/">https://www.nicta.gov.pg/cp-0-33/</a>

The public consultation will commence on Friday 06 September 2024 and run for five weeks. The deadline for written submissions is 4 pm on Friday 11 October 2024.
